- A positive 'can-do' attitude and the readiness to help the IB team develop new initiatives to enhance the IB curriculum

- A proven track record of excellent classroom and pedagogical practice, including responding effectively to differentiation and inclusion
- Excellent organizational and IT skills
- Knowledge and experience in the use of digital technologies to enhance pupils' learning
